

INSTRUCTIONS FOR GAMES

HANGMAN

- An English word is given above the “gallows”.
- The word or phrase to guess in the language you are studying (Latvian/ Russian / Spanish, etc.) is represented by the row of dashes, one for each letter.
- Click on the letter of the alphabet that you want to guess.
- Correct guesses will appear in the word or phrase.
- You have 6 tries to guess the word.
- For each incorrect guess, you will lose one try and get closer to being hung.
- Letters you have guessed correctly are shown in bold black and letters you have guessed incorrectly are shown in red.

CROSSWORD

- Click on a word to begin/continue. The word in English is given on the right.
- Translate the given word into the language you are studying: Latvian / Russian / Spanish, etc.

CRYPTEX

- Click on the answer button and translate the given word into the language you are studying (Latvian / Russian / Spanish) or find the word in the cryptex grid.
- If your answer is correct, it will be marked red in the grid.

SNAKES AND LADDERS

- Translate the given word into the language you are studying (Latvian / Russian / Spanish) and write your answer in the answer box.
- If your answer is right, the dice is rolled and a random number displayed.
- The game piece (a red star) is moved ahead that many squares.
- If the game piece is in the bottom of a ladder and your answer is correct, it goes to the top.
- If the game piece is in the tail of snake and your answer is wrong, it goes down to the head.

MILLIONAIRE

- Choose the right answer and click on the appropriate letter (A, B, C, or D).
- You must answer each question correctly to proceed.
- If your answer is right, a new question will appear on the screen.
- If your answer is wrong, the game is over.
- You have three lifelines (top of screen): go 50:50, phone a friend and ask the audience.
- If you click on the 50:50 button, 2 wrong answers will disappear and you will be able to select the right one from the remaining 2.
- If you click in the phone button, in the bottom-right corner you will see a possible answer, which may be right or wrong.

- If you click in the audience button, in the bottom-right corner you will see (in %) which answers the audience chose.
- To end or start a new game, click on the 'X' next to the lifelines (top of screen).

SUDOKU

- Translate the given word into the language you are studying (Latvian / Russian / Spanish) and write your answer in the answer box provided.
- If your answer is correct, an appropriate number will be slotted into the Sudoku grid.
- If your answer is incorrect, no number will be slotted into the Sudoku grid.
- You can also click on the remaining squares in the Sudoku grid and work out the right numbers to complete the game following the Sudoku rules: each of the nine blocks has to contain all the numbers 1-9 within its squares. Each number can only appear once in a row, column or box.
